Genealogical update.

I have had a number of contacts from other branches of the tree.

(The Bolstridges were from Nanna's Grandmother's first marriage). They have done a lot of research on the Bolstridges and the Barretts as well. They have given me some new information and I am sure there is much more to come.

The most interesting of the new information is that Eliza Greenwood (Nanna's Grandmother) was sent out to Australia from Ireland during the potato famine and was an orphan. Arriving in Australia at the age of 15yrs. Her name has been place on a memorial, situated in Hyde Park, to the orphans who were sent to Australia.

They also informed me that her second husband and Nanna's Grandfather, James Barrett, was sent to Australia as a convict. When I was speaking to the lady who told me she could not at that time tell me his crime.

I just hope that I eventually have as much luck with the Lynch side as well.

Trent achieved well at the State carnival, coming in at 11th place with a throw of 9.42meters.

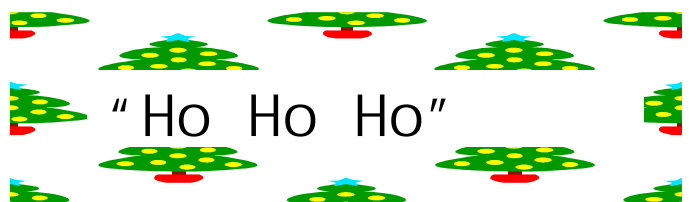
